Chinese Language & Art Classes at Malden YMCA

周末儿童班/ Saturday Youth Classes Time Member/non-member (per year)

双语中文 Bilingual Chinese I (Age 5-7) 8:30-10:00 AM (\$360/400/+ materials fee)

This class is designed for students without any Chinese learning background, or with no prior Mandarin learning experience. The objective of this class is focused on students' communicative ability in everyday social contexts. In addition, the teacher will introduce the basics of Chinese writing: such as basic strokes, stroke order, and radicals.

双语中文 Bilingual Chinese II (Age 6-8) 10:00-11:30 AM (\$360/400/+ materials fee)

This class is intended for children with little prior Mandarin exposure. Oral expression and vocabulary development remain a priority. Language games and role-playing are used to build practical skills. Includes review or introduction of the 4 tones; Chinese radical and basic stroke order, and rules to build up strong base for writing and character recognition. This work provides the foundation for reading and writing.

双语中文 Bilingual Chinese III (Age 8-10) 8:30-10:00 AM (\$360/400/+ materials fee)

This class continues to build upon the language competence gained from the previous year, and will center on themes that are relevant to daily life and culture. Chinese culture will be integrated into the class throughout the year. The basic communication skills of listening and speaking will be equally emphasized during instruction, with ample opportunities for practice. This class requires at least 2 years of prior Mandarin learning experience.

双语中文 Bilingual Chinese IV (Age 9-14) 10:00-11:30 AM (\$360/400/+materials fee)

This is an advanced class for experienced students, or students who have passed Bilingual Chinese III. The communication skills of listening and speaking will be heavily emphasized and practiced during instruction. This class requires over 3 years of prior Mandarin learning experience or Chinese teacher approval.

中文/Chinese (Age 8+) 10:00-11:30 AM (\$360/400/+materials fee)

Full immersion class with Mandarin instruction for learners with some prior Mandarin experience, or who speak Mandarin at home.

双语中文 Bilingual Chinese I (Age 5-7) 12:00-1:30 PM (\$360/400/+ materials fee)

This class is designed for students without any Chinese learning background or with no prior Mandarin learning experience. The objective of this class is focused on students' communicative ability in everyday social contexts. In addition, the teacher will introduce the basics of Chinese writing: such as basic strokes, stroke order, and radicals.

双语中文 Bilingual Chinese II (Age 6-8) 11:30-1:00 PM (\$360/400/+ materials fee)

This class is intended for children with little prior Mandarin exposure. Oral expression and vocabulary development remain a priority. Language games and role-playing are used to build practical skills. Includes review or introduction of the 4 tones; Chinese radical and basic stroke order and rules to build up strong base for writing and character recognition. The fee structure for the following classes is based on 12 weeks per period unless indicated.

Mommy & Me Chinese (Age 2-5) 11:30AM-12:30 PM (\$240 material included)

For parents who are interested in bilingual education with their young, this class is tailored just for you. The classes are conducted bilingually so that both adult and children with no prior exposure to Chinese can join in the fun. Simple Chinese characters and phrases will be the base of curriculum. Learning activities may include music and physical movement, arts and crafts, storytelling, interactive puppet shows and themed games.

Tutoring various levels of math, from homework support to advanced grade level of drills and practice to increase confidence

***英语辅导 /English tutoring 10:00 AM - 11:00 AM \$160/\$200**

Support vocabulary building, composition, reading comprehension and speaking and develop confidence!

*** 理科学辅导/science tutoring 11:00 AM - 12:00 PM \$160/\$200**

Tutoring various levels of science, from homework support to advanced grade level support

***数英理三科/Math/Science/English 9:00 AM - 12:00 PM \$400/\$460**

Combined the 3 subjects together for the 3 hours of drilling.

中国武术/Chinese Gongfu I & II 10:00 -11:00 AM/11:00 AM-12:00 PM \$160/\$200

Introduction to Chinese Martial art for beginners or students with at least one year of classes, ages 5-13, taught by a World Wushu Champion teacher.

小提琴/Violin Private Lesson 9:00 AM – 11:00 AM \$420/\$450

Introduction to violin for beginners (30-minute lesson) – Understanding beat, rhythm, and scales, children also learn how to divide, create fractions, and recognize patterns. It helps develop concentration, an important key to all aspects of learning.

小提琴/Violin Group Lesson 11:00 AM - 12:00 PM \$160/\$200

Introduction to violin (50-minute lesson)- Understanding beat, rhythm and scales, children also learn how to divide, create fractions, and recognize patterns. It also helps develop concentration, an important key to all learning. Small class size (5-8) for students ages between 5-13.

钢琴/Piano Private Lesson 8:30 AM – 1:00 PM \$420/\$450

Introduction to Piano (30 minutes) As described above, exposing children to music helps develop their concentration, memory, eye-hand coordination, which are important keys to all learning. Taught by a professional pianist from the New England Conservatory of Music.

钢琴/Piano Group Lesson (4-6 students) TBA \$160/\$200

Introduction to Piano for beginners, designed to teach the basic fingering techniques, chords, music notes, and practice with the music instructor. Taught by a professional pianist from the New England Conservatory of Music. Students will need to bring their own keyboard for the classes.

美术/Creative Art I & II 9:00 AM - 10:00 AM \$160/\$200

This class is the perfect place for young artists to develop their art skills. No prior experience necessary. Students will learn a variety of different artistic techniques.

美术/Creative Art I & II 12:00 PM- 1:00 PM \$160/\$200

This class is the perfect place for young artists to develop their art skills. No prior experience necessary. Students will learn a variety of different artistic techniques.

美术/Creative Art III & VI 1:00 PM- 2:00 PM \$160/\$200

This class is designed for young artists who have at least a couple of years of experience, and wish to build more complicated techniques to develop their art skills. Students will learn a variety of different artistic techniques with ease.

数英理三科/Math/Science/English 12:30 PM - 3:30 PM \$400/\$460

Combined the 3 subjects together for the 3 hours drilling.

围棋/WeiQi (GO) TBA \$150/\$180

WeiQi (Go) has a creativity and constructiveness missing from other games, whose object is to destroy or conquer. Go's creativity lets you freely express your ideas. Playing WeiQi (Go) helps one to develop concentration, alertness, and judgment, and it fosters a sense of balance.

***中国经典 / Chinese Classics TBA \$150/\$180**

Reciting Chinese classics at a very young age is like saving the ancient wisdom in the child's head. While the memory is strong, children learn and strengthen their virtuous character through singing and reciting the ancient classics. Free for Students who have attended 3 or more subjects.

- **CCC offers small classes, but requires a minimum of 4-5 students to open one.**

- **书法/Calligraphy: Beginner to Intermediate Sun./周日 10:00 AM- 12:00 PM \$150/\$200**
Chinese calligraphy is regarded as the most abstract and sublime art form in Chinese culture. Chinese calligraphy is both an artistic and physical practice. It can elevate one's body, mind and spirit from internal and external practices. It has been regarded as a good way to strengthen one's will and lead to a healthy life. Through the writing of Chinese classics, one will also gain some insight to the Chinese philosophy.
- **国画/Chinese Painting: Beginner/Inter Sat/周六 1:00 PM- 2:30 PM \$150/\$200**
Similar to Chinese calligraphy, Chinese painting is also regarded highly in Chinese society, even today. This class will focus on learning how to paint birds, plants and flowers to build the dexterity of brush stroke handling for more complicated landscape and human and animal figuring.
- **中文/Mandarin: Beginner Sat/周六 2:00 PM- 4:00 PM \$250/\$300**
This is an introductory course (beginner level) for learning the basics of Mandarin Chinese. It will cover pronunciation, tones, and basic grammar of Mandarin Chinese. Students will be able to conduct some simple conversations starting from session one. The course will also teach students how to recognize and write some simple Chinese characters.

Students will be able to conduct some simple conversations starting from session one. The course will also teach student how to recognize and write some simple Chinese characters.
